3. A project or initiative where the nominee has gone over and above their normal role.

Nominees can either apply personally or be nominated by their line manager / colleagues / parents. All applications must include a rationale behind why the candidate should be awarded this prestigious award. The prize for the winning application will be £1000, used to implement something that will impact practice or education fields or travel associated with either of these, as well as a year's membership with the NNA. The winner will be announced at the NNA National Conference in March. The winner will be asked to write a small article on their achievements for the Journal of Neonatal Nursing and they will need to present this at the next conference.
